SLC and Library create Brave New World!


Recently the Student

funds to purchase popular films
and then distributed them to the
three libraries.

A total of \$500.00 was allocated by the SLC for the purchase of the films. The focus of the purchase was to provide students with more choices for their viewing pleasure.

Among the titles purchased were Game of Thrones: Season 2; Here Comes the Boom; Argo (Academy Award for Best Picture); Sinister; The Dark Knight Rises; and TED. Older films added to the catalog included Gremlins,

The Shining, A Clockwork Orange, and One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest.

CREDO reference is an electronic database of books that can aid in research. The database has 100 books with facts and data. The books are accessible from the library resource page. Subjects of current interest include: gun control, along with medical

reference, CIA World Facts, dictionaries, and encyclopedias.

Done with your most current research project (finally)? Stop and relax by reading the *Encyclopedia of Urban Legends* and learn about The Disappearing Hitchhiker

Interlibrary Loan (ILL) system allows libraries around the world to lend to and borrow from each other. There is no charge to use either service. Last year the NGTC Libraries borrowed and

loaned almost 300 books including loaning two to library users in Europe!
